



- ➤ Debt of Maharashtra State currently stands at Rs 2.09 Lakh Crores (2011)
- Debt is projected to increase to Rs 2.31 Lakh Crores by March 2012
- ➤ This Huge Debt prevents State Govt from doing big projects


Large projects are not possible unless Maharashtra's debt is significantly reduced






- ✓ Port Traffic is Choking City's Road and Rail network
- Mumbai Eastern Seaboard to be Re-Developed after Re-Locating :
 - Mumbai Port Trust, FCI, Railways
 - RCF, BPCL & HPCL
- ✓ All Re-Located Facilities will be provided with financing for latest equipment and <u>capacity expansion</u> at a new location on land provided by Govt of Maharashtra.
 - Relocation Critical in order to prevent possible disasters due to leakage of lethal chemicals like Ammonia, Chlorine and to avoid Crude Oil spills that are occurring frequently
 - These Industries with huge toxic chemical tanks are also prime terror targets. Pose Serious Threat.

- ✓ Specified Penalties for offenders ... loss of house and work permit in Mumbai.
- ✓ High speed rail link to those who choose low rise accommodation elsewhere in MMR as space is critical.
- ✓ Increasing FSI to 12–16 levels is critical





Concept 10: The 72 Contractor Territories





- MMR to be divided into **72** squares for project execution purposes
- These 72 Work Areas will be put out on International Competitive Bidding
- The Megaproject will feature 12 design concepts and 12 Large projects
- The worlds largest and Best Design firms will compete with local companies & Govt Agencies to develop & design concepts for each project area. The best conceptual designs will be awarded the detailed design contracts. Evaluation will be by a panel of global experts.
- 72 Contractor Territories to be awarded to 12 Large Global Consortia with work Value of US \$ 30 Billion Each. Indian Companies to compete on same terms as Foreign EPC Contractors

Concept 11: Town Planning As a Biddable Item



- India produces just 200 Town Planners each year
- > Total Townplanners Employed in India presently is 3300...for a total of 5600 Towns
- Govt. Agencies in Maharashtra do not have required number of Town Planners for Mumbai Megaproject
- Further there is large Scale Corruption in getting permissions and the city has grown in a totally un-planned manner
- ➤ There will therefore be a separate Town Planning Round, right at the beginning of the Mumbai Megaproject. Govt Agencies to Compete on Par with Private Players
- > Megaproject Bidding Process Monitored by International Panel of Independent Experts



Concept 12: Highly Accountable / Visible Project System


- Politically Accountable Authority Required to spearhead Megaproject
- Megaproject CEO will be Construction Expert (Either Indian / Foreign) with Acknowledged Leadership In The Construction Industry Globally
- Megaproject Management / Construction Team to be hired from around the world based on expert skill sets
- All Contracts to be awarded after International Competitive Bidding
- Separate Bidding Rounds For Town Planning & EPC ...World Bank / EU Standards
- All Project Activity to be controlled through Highly Advanced IT System which ensures three things:
 - ✓ Visibility / Transparency
 - ✓ Accountability & Measurement of Outcomes
 - ✓ Preservation of Context.
 - ✓ Entire Decision Making Hierarchy To Be Mapped ... Deviations will Trigger A System Alert



- 1. Govt. To Initate Re-Location Discussions with Mumbai Port Trust, RCF, HPCL & BPCL, FCI & Railways
- 2. Appoint Surveyors / Consultants For Alternative Sites for Port/Industrials which allow for expansion of capacities
- 3. Fast Track Issue of UID Numbers to All Residents of the MMR
- 4. Varification of Detailed Demographic Data & Property Holdings & Mapping this to UID's for All Of Dwellings within MMR
- 5. Appointment of Project CEO / Staff for Megaproject. Executive Search firms to be commissioned to recruit highly specialized planning and execution team of 250 Project Managers, 2000 Engineers & 600 Architects / Townplanners from around the world

Government Support Required



- Megaproject needs politically accountable authority to spearhead project.
- State Government Needs to Order Relocation Of Harbour Based Industries
 & Mumbai Port Trust
- Project requires highly specialized team of owner managers (250 Project Managers, 2000 Engineers, 600 Architects / Townplanners Etc. Highly specialized construction team will need to be recruited internationally.
- One Time Grant of Rs 3000 Crores From JNNURM to finance Project Team Salaries

Fully Empowered Political Authority <u>Is Critical</u> For Project Execution ... Megaproject is <u>Totally Self Financing</u> After Initial JNNURM Grant of Rs 3000 Crores
